A Summary of Actions by the Board of Trustees

Regular Meeting of April 10, 2006

The Board of Trustees met on Monday, April 10, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of holding a regular meeting. Members present were: President, John R. Williams; Vice-President, Karen Thornton; Secretary, David Spiller; Howard Kessinger; Roxanna Maddox; Clinton Farris; and Gary Zeitler.

Action Items:

- The Board voted to hire Josh Potter for Athletic Director/Head Football Coach.
- The Board voted to approve the consent agenda items.

Information Items:

- Mr. Bennett informed the Board that he has accepted the following resignations: April Belyeu, Melissa McCurry, Earl Gandy, and Chris Joslin.
- Brett Thomas presented the Board with the technology report and update.
- High School Principal, Mr. Burnett, reported enrollment at 270 for High School and 6 students at the Learning Center. He reported the High School activities planned for April; TAKS Tutorial Schedule; TAKS Testing Schedule; Zone One Act Play All Star Cast and Honorable Mention; District UIL Academic Meet results; 2005-2006 Student Council Officers and Cheerleaders; NHS Inductions and JHS Prom Report. He also reported on basketball; baseball; softball; track; and golf. The Band has a spring trip scheduled April 27 – 29 to San Antonio. The activities, results of of the State FBLA Convention, the FCCLA State Competition and the FFA Spring Career Development Events were also reported. Mrs. Zeitler reported Elementary enrollment at 463. She reported PTA Fun Day was a success; 2nd grade went to the Fort Worth Stockyards for their annual field trip; Mrs. Lewis and Mrs. Sewell

took Pre-K students to the Bedford Clubhouse for Kids; 3rd grade is going to the Omni; and 5th six weeks citizens will attend the Lions Club luncheon. Mrs. Zeitler also reported Easter parties will be on Thursday; 5th grade will travel to NASA for their field trip and 4th grade field trip will be to the capitol in Austin. She also gave the board TAKS testing schedule for Elementary.
