A Summary of Actions by the Board of Trustees

Regular Meeting of October 9, 2006

The Board of Trustees met on Monday, October 9, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. for the purpose holding a regular meeting. Members present were: President, John R. Williams; Vice-President, Gary Zeilter; Secretary, David Spiller; Roxanna Maddox; Howard Kessinger; Clinton Farris; Brent Hackley; and Superintendent, Dennis Bennett.

#### Action Items:

- The Board voted to approve the 2006-2007 District Improvement Plan and the 2006-2007 Campus Improvement Plans as presented.
- The Board voted to approve the consent agenda items.

#### Information Items:

- Christy Thomas reported the FIRST (Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas) Rating was of Superior Achievement.
- Principals' Reports:
- High School principal, Brad Burnett, reported enrollment at 287 for High School and 13 students at the Learning Center. He reported the High School activities planned for October. He gave information on volleyball, football, cross country and basketball. The Band will compete in the UIL Marching Contest in Denton on Saturday, October 21<sup>st</sup>. Mr. Burnett also reported on FFA and FCCLA.  
Mr. O'Steen, Middle School principal, reported 196 students enrolled at Middle School. Veterans Day Program. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Football wins and losses were also reported by Mr. O'Steen.

Mrs. Zeitler, Elementary Principal, reported enrollment at 487.
