King received his B.S. degree in Agriculture Education from Texas Tech in 1949. He operated a registered Herford ranch near Jermyn before being employed in 1962 with Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association as a field inspector. Later, he was commissioned as a special Texas Ranger who investigated cattle thefts and offenses committed against cattlemen and their property.

Also, King served as Special Assistant to the Secretary-General Manager of TSCRA before his appointment in 1966 to his present position as Secretary-General.

King is a member of several civic and fraternal organizations. He was past president of International Livestock Brand Conference, and Texas County Agriculture Agents named him "Man of the Year in Agriculture" in 1977.
