



School Health Advisory Council Meeting

The Jacksboro ISD School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) met on June 16, 2020, in the JISD Boardroom. The meeting was called to order at 12:00 noon. In attendance were Alinda Cox, Dwain Milam, Brad Burnett, Craig Adkins, Tonya Treadway, Teresa Howard, Terri Stretcher, Yecenia DeSantiago, Staci Kenvin, Karen Vanderkaay, Julie Seibold, and Starla Sanders.

3. Child nutrition update - Craig Adkins, Child Nutrition Director
 - Mr. Adkins reported that the district served over 42,000 meals during the closure for COVID-19 from mid-March through May 21. Meals were offered for curbside pickup at Jacksboro Middle School or home delivery by the JISD transportation department. Mr. Adkins acknowledged Transportation Director, Greg Sanders, and his bus drivers for assisting with meal delivery. As of June 8, JISD Child Nutrition is serving breakfast, lunch, and supper for the TDA Summer Feeding Program. These meals will be offered through July 3. Rolling Plains Cooperative is providing transportation services for summer meal deliveries for up to 180 students daily. Meals are also provided for students attending ESL summer school at JES and credit recovery at JHS.
4. Review the District's response to COVID-19
 - Mr. Milam provided a review of the district's response to the COVID-19 closure. The district followed TEA and CDC guidance in developing plans for the graduation ceremony which were approved by local emergency management officials. Mr. Milam developed a screening questionnaire that graduating seniors and student-athletes were required to complete in order to enter district facilities. JES Principal, Michael Qualls developed a COVID-19 Summer School Plan that outlines protocols for staff and students participating in ESL Summer School. The district is awaiting recommendations from TEA to finalize plans for starting school in August.
5. Back to School Fair
 - Alinda Cox provided an update on plans from distributing school supplies to students in need. She would like to continue to provide an opportunity



for vendors to get information to parents. Mrs. Cox will schedule a meeting with JES administrators to discuss the possibility of incorporating the Back to School Fair with Meet the Teacher Night

6. State-mandated training related to health & wellness

- Brad Burnett reviewed the district's plan to comply with state-mandated health and wellness trainings. The district will use the Helen Farabee Center to provide Mental Health First Aid training for staff during in-service. The Jacksboro Fire Department will provide Stop the Bleed training for staff during in-service and students in grades 7-12 during the fall semester. The district contracts with United Health Systems to offer BLS/CPR/AED certification courses to employees on July 14 and 28, 2020. Students in 9th and 12th grade will receive BLS/CPR/AED training during the school year from certified district staff. The district partners with Wise Hope to provide training to students on Dating Violence Prevention, Healthy Relationships, and Bullying Awareness and Prevention.

7. Health & wellness updates by campus

- Elementary - JES Counselor, Teresa Howard, is planning to offer play therapy sessions for students dealing with emotional challenges. JES Nurse, Tonya Treadway is working to get approval to provide shot clinics on campus to assist parents to comply with immunization requirements.
- Middle School - JMS Counselor, Terrie Stretcher, provided information on Rhithm which is a social-emotional tracking software program. Mrs. Stretcher is also looking for opportunities to utilize the school nurse to provide hygiene instruction to middle school students.
- High School - JHS Principal, Starla Sanders, updated the council on the Tiger Den food and hygiene product box. The JHS Science Club has been collecting donated clothing items for students in need.
